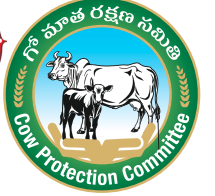

Key Features of a 12A Certificate Tax Exemption:

Once registered under Section 12A, the organization's total income is exempt from income tax, provided the funds are used for charitable purposes.
One-Time Registration: Traditionally, this was a one-time process. However, under current regulations, organizations must now apply for re-validation every 5 years.
Eligibility: It is available to religious trusts, charitable trusts, Welfare Societies, and Section 8 companies.

80G: AABAF2888BF20251: The 80G Certificate is an approval from the Income Tax Department that allows donors (individuals or companies) to claim a tax deduction on the donations they make to your organization.

81B BYLAWS : Key Responsibilities under 81B Under these bylaws, the Managing Committee holds specific duties:
Appointment of Auditor: The society must appoint an auditor from a panel approved by the State Government or the Registrar.
Access to Records: The committee must provide all books of accounts, vouchers, and documents to the auditor.
General Body Presentation: The audit report must be presented before the Annual General Body Meeting (AGM).

CSR No. CSR00090241: Introduced by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) in April 2021, this registration ensures that an NGO is officially verified to carry out CSR activities on behalf of a company. Upon successful filing of Form CSR-1, the NGO receives a unique CSR Registration Number. **CSR00090241**



MSME: MSME stands for Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises. Often called the "backbone of the economy," these businesses contribute significantly to a country's GDP, exports, and employment. In India, the definition of MSMEs was revised under the Aatmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan (2020) to include both manufacturing and service sectors under a single set of criteria based on Investment and Annual Turnover.

NITI Aayog/Darpan Registration: NO. TS 23/0365391

The NGO Darpan Unique ID is a digital identity issued by NITI Aayog (the Government of India's policy think tank).

It acts as a centralized validation for NGOs, similar to how an Aadhaar card works for individuals. Here is the essential information: What is it? It is a unique registration number assigned to Voluntary Organizations (VOs) and NGOs (Trusts, Societies, or Section 8 Companies) when they register on the NGO Darpan portal. It was created to bring transparency and bridge the gap between the government and the non-profit sector.

UDYAM REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE No.: DL-TS-02-0237638

The Udyam Registration Certificate (formerly known as Udyog Aadhaar) is an official recognition issued by the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME). While traditionally for businesses, NGOs, Trusts, and Societies can also register if they provide services (like education, healthcare, or vocational training). Here is the short information you need: What is it? It is a permanent registration and a unique identification number (URN) for an enterprise. It classifies your organization as Micro, Small, or Medium based on your investment in equipment and annual turnover.

LEI (LEGAL ENTITY IDENTIFIER) CERTIFICATE: 9045009694DZWFB6FB18

1. What is it? The LEI is a global standard (ISO 17442) designed to improve transparency in the financial system. It allows regulators and banks to track who is involved in large-scale transactions across the world. 2. When is it Mandatory for an NGO? In India, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has made LEI mandatory for non-individual entities in the following cases: Large Transactions: If your NGO performs a single NEFT or RTGS transaction of ₹50 Crore or more, you must have an LEI. Large Borrowings: If your NGO has total credit exposure (loans or credit facilities) of ₹5 Crore or more from any bank or financial institution. Foreign Exchange: It is increasingly required for cross-border transactions and certain derivative contracts. 3. Key Features Global Recognition: It is recognized in over 180 countries, making it easier for NGOs to work with international donors or foundations

E-ANUDAAN DASH BOARD

The e-Anudaan Dashboard (also spelled E-Anudan) is an online portal launched by the Government of India to digitize the application and management of Grants-in-Aid (GIA) for NGOs. It is primarily managed by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MoSJE) and the Ministry of Tribal Affairs. Think of it as the "Single Window" for applying for government money for social projects.

ACTIVITY REPORT

An activity report is an internal document that summarizes completed project activities over a specific timeframe. It helps keep employees and managers informed about progress, priorities, and potential bottlenecks, and can also be used to communicate project status to clients
